The Annual report showcases the achievements and glories of our school. We have always been committed to create a conducive environment in the school which helps the young minds to blossom and provide a platform for the holistic development of the students' personality and also moulding them to be better citizens.

RESULTS AT A GLANCE:

I wish to begin with our performance on the academic front. Achieving academic excellence is at the heart of our endeavour as educators. I am happy to present the details of the commendable performance of our students in the Board Examinations. Here, I would like to highlight with pride that our school toppers who were All India Top Scorers as well, have been invited in the past years by the Ministry of Education, Government of India to witness the Republic Day parade and have also been felicitated for their meritorious performance.

STD. XII Board Examination, March 2022 - School First and Second.

- In Class 12, Secondary School Certificate Examinations, 2022, from the Science Stream, Mith R Jain secured school first and scored 498/500 and Kailash Gopal. D secured second place and scored 496/500.
- In Commerce Stream, V. Manav Bafna secured school first with 488/500 and S. Ranjith secured the second place and has scored 486/500.

CENTUM SCORERS

This year's Board result has been exceptional with:

- 86 students securing Centum in different subjects.
- **18** in Mathematics, 13 in Physics, 16 in Chemistry, 27 in Computer Science, 9 in Business Studies, 1 in Accountancy, 1 in Applied Mathematics and 1 in History have scored centum.

Out of 475 students, 250 secured 90% aggregate and above in Std. XII Board Examinations.

SUCCESS IN ENTRANCE EXAMINATIONS

Our school students have made us proud with the phenomenal success in different entrance examinations.

One hundred and fifty five students (155) of Class 12, 2021 – 2022 batch cleared the prestigious IIT Mains Examination. This year more than 50% of the aspirants have got into IITs. 55 students have cleared the NEET Examination and many students are successfully pursuing their courses in different IITs, Medical Colleges, NITs, Top Law colleges and other reputed National and International Institutions. In addition to that, about 50% of our Commerce stream students pursue the high profile CA Course.

SECONDARY SCHOOL EXAMINATION:

Our Std X result was remarkable too.

492 students have successfully cleared the Secondary School Examinations, 2022. B. Nandhinee, Nihal Pinisetti & Niranjan Ram.R have secured the school topper position scoring 493/500. Shrida Kanthimathi Ranganath, S. Nandhish Kumar, Arun. S and Dev Akhilesh Ram L.A. have secured second place scoring 492/500. 42 students secured centum in different subjects. Two in English, Five in Tamil, Two in Sanskrit, Twenty one in Mathematics, Nine in Science and three in Social Science have secured Centum.

NTSE AND KVPY

Every year our school students have proved their grit and calibre by excelling in both NTSE and KVPY Exams. This year 186 students have appeared for National Talent Search Examination(NTSE) stage I exam and 38 have secured scholarship in the Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana (KVPY) Exam, 2021.
